## Minutes Regular Council Meeting Wednesday, July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2014 at 7:00pm.

Mayor Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:05pm.

Council Members present were Debbra Morgan, Craig Davidson, Adene Wuertley, and Lowell Clawson.

Also present were Attorney David Erickson, Acting Town Clerk Jenny Evans, Maintenance Man Wallace Godwin, and Police Officers Tony Rigano and Scott Dick.

Guest present was Field Production Superintendent Dene Martin, with Memorial Production Operating LLC.

### **Public Comment:**

Council Member Wuertley would like to publicly recognize Jasmine Gould for her accomplishments showing in the National Finals High School Rodeo – Bairoil is rooting for you! Council Member Wuertley would also like to thank the Fire Department for putting on a spectacular display – it was amazing!

Field Production Superintendent Dene Martin told the council a little about the background of Memorial Production Operating LLC. It is a publicly traded company out of Houston Texas. From his experience with Memorial they seem to be very civic-minded, open, and transparent. He believes they will be great partners with the Town of Bairoil and with the State of Wyoming. Mr. Martin wanted to let the Council Members, Mayor, and the Town of Bairoil that if anyone has any concerns or questions he would like people to come to him and he will help any way he can.

Approval of July 2<sup>nd</sup> 2014 Minutes:

With no changes, the minutes stand as written.

Approval of the Amended Agenda for July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2014:

Mayor Rigano moved Pay Bills to #4 under New Business, Truck Bids to #3 under New Business and Trencher Park progress to #4 under Mayor's Report. Council Member Morgan made a motion to accept the amended agenda, Council Member Clawson seconded, motion passed.

## Monthly Reports:

Police: Officer Rigano stated that there were 3 citations equaling \$115.00. Mayor Rigano reported that there was no court held on July 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2014 – all citations for this court date have been paid. The next scheduled court date is August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

#### Water:

Licensed Operator Tony Rigano reported that the water level is normal; the average daily usage is 57,800 gallons. The use of Battle Springs is minimal. The chlorine is averaging about 0.5 and our tank level remains somewhere from the 36' to 38' range. The sewers are working fine. He had Dean Miles clear out the duck weed on the north lagoon.

### Maintenance:

Maintenance Man Wallace Godwin reported the following:

- The 'Bairoil Community Center and Town Hall' sign has been redone and is back in place.
- He has been building up the berms around the burn pit
- The grapple bucket worked great to put wood into the pit; it cut his time down by over half
- people are now using the fenced in area by the burn pit this is working great for Mr. Godwin
- He poured slabs of concrete in the park and placed 2 benches and 2 garbage cans on and laid gravel underneath (This looks great!)
- He would like to replace the old picnic tables with new metal ones so the garbage cans, benches, and picnic tables would all be the same.
- He knocked down and removed the old rock memorial in the park
- The new 'Welcome to Bairoil' sign was moved to right hand side of Indian Paintbrush Ave and set at an angle so it's easier for people to see.

There was no fire report.

There will be a door to enter/exit, and it will have a lock on it.

#### Trencher Park:

The concrete slab has been poured for the trencher to be placed on. A crane truck and a trackhoe will be used to place the trencher on the pad.

Research Clerk LB Brantner is working on getting bids for fencing around Trencher Park and the Old Town Hall.
