Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday June 20th, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.
Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Adene Wuertley and Debra Morgan.
Others present were Attorney Mike Roberts and Clerk Ashley Jones.
Employees present were Police Chief Larry Prince and Maintenance Man Wallace Godwin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the Minutes for June 6, 2018 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Debra Morgan and seconded by Adene Wuertley to amend the agenda of June 20, 2018. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: There's been an increase of people out and less bicyclist's then normal this year. There was one minor accident within the last couple weeks that involved a couple oilfield trucks.

Court: All citations have been paid and received no report from Sheri Shillinger.

Water/Sewer:

The water system is in good shape usage is normal, the tank this morning was at 34ft, chlorine was 0.4. There are no leaks, the bio tests were sent in and they passed. The sewer/lagoon is normal.

Maintenance: Replaced the downspout at the library that was broken, rototilled the riding arena. The bathrooms at the park are now open. The park will be closed from Monday

June 25th through Monday July 2nd 2018 due to weed and grass control, got one burn in and still has some trimming to do. The basketball court is closed due to metal that's popping up through the cement. EPA surface water test will be done next year.

Fire: Meeting held on June 7, 2018; seven volunteer firemen attended this meeting. They talked about stuff, drove the trucks and planned stuff out. Volunteer firemen Stetler Hopkin resigned from the fire department.

Mayor's Report:

The Water Development Application deadline has moved to March 1, 2019.

We received a reimbursement from Rocky Mountain Power Watt Smart for the completion of the gymnasium project in the amount of \$932.04.

Old Business:

A motion was made by Councilmen Lowell Clawson to pass on the Third and final reading on Animal Ordinances #18-002. Adene Wuertley seconded it. Motion passed.

New Business:

The council had a discussion about purchasing a Secure Certificate for the Towns Website. More information would be needed to make this decision.

There is a council seat vacancy, the deadline for applications will be Tuesday July 17, 2018.

A motion was made by Debra Morgan and seconded by councilmen Lowell Clawson to select a date for the first council meeting in July due to Independence Day. It will be held on Wednesday July 18, 2018.

A motion was made by Debra Morgan to accept Police Chief Larry Prince's letter of resignation. Councilmen Lowell Clawson seconded it. Motion passed. Adene Wuertley apposed.

Pay Bills:

Councilman Lowell Clawson made a motion to pay bills Check # 13015 through Check #13044 including debit card charges and EFT's for the total amount of \$ 26,123.81. Debra Morgan seconded it. Motion passed.
