Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday June 6th, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson, Debra Morgan and Adene Wuertley.

Others present were Attorney Mike Roberts and Clerk Ashley Jones.

Guests present were H. Smith, Bob Wuertley, Fred and Donna Kunkel, Kenny and Barb Osborn, Buck and Kim Osborn and Lee Sulzen.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: Kenny Osborn wanted to thank everyone for their hard work and donations for the display case.

1103A Wellers Lot Rental: Wellers request to put a regular trailer home on a camper lot. A discussion ensued among Council and Attorney Mike Roberts. Camper lots were designed for temporary campers. The electrical on lots does not meet the requirement for a full size and permanent trailer home. Therefore we cannot rent a camper lot to accommodate a full size trailer home.

Approval of the Minutes for May 16, 2018, as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Adene Wuertley and seconded by Debra Morgan to accept the agenda of June 6, 2018 as presented. Motion passed.

Mayor's Report:

Wallace requested to have the park closed down for one week, Monday June 25th 2018 to Monday July 2nd, 2018 to do weed and grass control. Also as to have his hours changed so he starts work at 5:30 a.m. The council agreed to have him start at 6 a.m. until 4 p.m. Not 5:30 a.m.

Old Business:

Union Wireless Representative was out on May 23, 2018. But was not present at this council meeting as requested by the Mayor.

Councilman Lowell Clawson made a motion to pass on the second reading on the Animal Ordinances #18-002, Dana Clawson seconded it. Motion passed.

New Business:

Blue Cross as of July 1st, 2018 the deductible will go from \$500.00 to \$1,500.00 a year. Employees will still be covered 100% and dependents will be covered at 50%. Retirement is still the same for Volunteer Fire Department \$15.00 a month per volunteer. Retirement for Law Enforcement. Town has to pay 100% retirement on Police Officers but if they want to add more money to their account they have to contribute out of their pocket whatever amount they choose up to 8.6%

Dana Clawson made a motion to raise the weight room fees on July 1, 2018. Residents can pay in installments of \$25.00 every quarter, \$50.00 for half the year or \$100.00 for the year. Debra Morgan seconded it. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Councilman Lowell Clawson to accept Adene Wuertleys's letter of resignation. Debra Morgan seconded it. Motion passed. Adene Wuertley abstained.

Pay Bills:

Councilman Lowell Clawson made a motion to pay bills Check # 12987 through Check # 13014 including debit card charges and EFT's for the total amount of \$52,302.43. Dana Clawson seconded it. Motion passed.

With no further business this meeting was adjourned at 7:39 p.m.
