Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday September 19, 2018 at 7 P.M.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Council Members present were Mayor Pro- Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson, Debbra Morgan and Gust Hatanelas.

Others present were Clerk Ashley Jones.

Employees present were Maintenance Man Wallace Godwin, Water / Sewer Tony Rigano and Police Officer Scott Gardner.

Guests present were Dean Martin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: The Rural Health District has a medical group based out of Rawlins that maybe interested in primary care and OCC medical employment.

Approval of the Minutes for September 5, 2018 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary, the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Debbra Morgan and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve the agenda of September 19, 2018. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: It's been pretty quiet lately, there were only two citations issued, one has been paid. Did two property watches until the owners returned, have had three groups of hunters in the area, one report of dogs running at large but were captured by owner and taken care of. Both police vehicles have had the batteries replaced and are running good.

Court: There was no court held on September 5, 2018, no citations were issued for that court date. The next scheduled court date is October 3, 2018.

Water / Sewer: The water looks good, the tank was at 36 feet and chlorine was 0.35. Bio well tests were sent to the EPA lab, chlorine residue was submitted in August. The sewer and lagoon are fine.

Maintenance: Cut grass at the school, park, town hall, RV lots and fire hydrants, the trees have been cut back and the residents who needed to have cut theirs back for winter. The sending unit on the dually will need to be replaced before winter along with the feeder belt. Did repairs on the fence at the leech

field and trimmed back branches. There was a water leak on Indian Paintbrush from the main line that was found and fixed.

Fire: They had three fire department meetings held August 22, 2018. Six volunteers were present for this meeting. They discussed new meetings and times, training and equipment needed and planning on hydrant testing. On August 29, 2018 there were three volunteers present for this meeting. They did pressure and flow testing on the fire hydrants. Their third fire meeting was held on September 6, 2018. There were six volunteers present for this meeting. They discussed their next meeting and training, also did truck checks and gear checks. Fire truck E2 has been taking in and repaired and ready to be picked up, did inventory on the fire gear, some of the volunteers will be needing some new gear. Their goal is to get some EMR basic training and EMT first aid. They have been putting together a coverage schedule so that there are volunteers here on the weekend in case of an emergency. They will be doing a fire training on October 4, 2018. Iris to Badger Circle will be blocked off during this time for a few hours.

Mayor's Report: Bairoil cleanup day has been changed to Saturday September 22, 2018 from 10:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Old Business: Joe came and looked at the vent on the well, said that we should get in contact with an engineer who specializes in wells to come out and look at it to get it fixed for winter.

Gust Hatanelas made a motion and Councilman Lowell Clawson seconded it to accept the bid of \$100.00 from Debbie Good for the refrigerator from the school. Motion passed.

New Business: A motion was made by Gust Hatanelas and seconded by Debbra Morgan to purchase a BowFlex Tread Climber model TC200 for the weight room from Lowell Clawson for \$1,500.00. Motion passed. Lowell Clawson and Dana Clawson abstained.

Pay Bills: A motion was made by Councilman Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to pay Check # 13197 through Check # 13224 including debit card charges and EFT's in the amount of \$12,944.29. Excluding Check # 13189 and Check # 13218. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Debbra Morgan and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to pay Check # 13189 and Check # 13218 to Plus Electric. Motion passed. Lowell Clawson and Dana Clawson abstained.

With no further business this meeting was adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
