Minutes  
Regular Council Meeting  
Wednesday September 5, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.  
Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson and Gust Hatanelas.  
Others present were Attorney Mike Roberts and Clerk Ashley Jones.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: Anthony Armstrong and Scott Gardner were sworn into office as the new Police Officers.

Approval of the Minutes for August 15, 2018 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

The weight room equipment is old and breaking so a discussion ensued with the council about purchasing gently used equipment. A form has been posted in the weight room on what equipment you would like to see in there.

The Town is renting two brothers a lot for hunting season. They will be here September through October. Jenny Evans parents rented a lot on September 7 through September 9, 2018.

Sheri Lyon had sent papers on an EMT class starting September 11, 2018 in Rawlins.


A motion was made by Councilman Lowell Clawson and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to put the refrigerator at the school up for bid. Starting bid is \$100.00 and all bids must be in by September 18, 2018. Motion passed.
