Regular Council Meeting  
Wednesday August 15, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.  
Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson, Debbra Morgan and Gust Hatanelas.  
Others present were Attorney Mike Roberts and Clerk Ashley Jones.  
Employees present were Maintenance Man Wallace Godwin.  
Guests present were Scott Gardner and Anthony Armstrong.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the Minutes for August 1, 2018 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary, the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Councilman Lowell Clawson and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to approve the agenda of August 15, 2018. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: There was none
