Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday July 17, 2019 at 7 p.m.

Mayor Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson, Gust Hatanelas and Debra Morgan.

Others present Attorney Mike Roberts and Clerk Ashley Jones.

Employee present Maintenance Man Wallace Godwin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the minutes for July 2, 2019 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary, the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Debra Morgan and seconded by Dana Clawson to amend the agenda of July 17, 2019. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: There was none.

Court: There was no court held on July 10, 2019, no citations were issued. The next scheduled court date is August 7, 2019.

Water/Sewer: The water tank level is at 34.4 feet down from 38.4 when completely full, status is excellent for this time of year. Chlorine level varies from 0.3 to 0.5 depending on input flow. Bio tests have been sent in at 0.4 chlorine residual level will pass, Rad-Nuc tests were sent in for the second quarter results go to the EPA as requested. Sewer lagoons have no problems both are functioning as they should with no overflow. Mark Court of Rural Water conducted a class on waste water at Town Hall on July 10 in preparation for DEQ testing.

Maintenance: The grass has been cut and at 411 Indian Paintbrush the cleanup has been completed, sewer/lagoon flushing has been started over at the corrals then will continue for the rest of the town. The fire hall roof has been repaired but will need to replace the rest of the rubbers and screws throughout the roof so it doesn't leak again. The pump at the well house was backed up with scale, got that cleaned out and working good now. The blades on the brush cutter are not working well so the blades will have to be grinded down.

Fire: On June 20, 2019 there were six volunteers present for their meeting. They drove and worked on trucks, made a plan to do hydrant testing on July 3, and talked about finishing FF1 training and taking the final test.

Mayor's Report: The Mayor from Green River called and asked if we would support them in the 6th Penny tax. When the date and time are announced Mayor Rigano will be going to Rock Springs to attend.

Old Business: The camper lot rates will be discussed in a workshop then put on the agenda.

New Business: A motion was made by Gust Hatanelas and seconded by Dana Clawson to allow Amplify to dump wood that they have at the burn place in a designated area and a notice will go out to the public who would like to go through it to get ahold of Wallace and meet him to look at it and take what you want.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to pay Check # 13774 through Check # 13799 including all EFT's and debit charges for the total amount of \$ 10,700.80. Motion passed.

With no further business this council meeting was adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
