Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday June 5, 2019 at 7 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson and Debbra Morgan. Gust Hatanelas was excused.
Others present Attorney Mike Roberts and Clerk Ashley Jones.
Guests present were Bob and Adene Wuertley, Roslyn and Dennis Fish, Fred and Donna Kunkel and Doreen Garrison.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: Adene Wuertley wanted to talk about the Church using the ballfield. Mayor Rigano said that it was going to be discussed later in the meeting.

Approval of the minutes for May 15, 2019 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary, the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Debbra Morgan and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve the agenda of June 5, 2019. Motion passed.

Mayor's Report: A notice will be going out to all residents of volunteers needed to go around and pick up windblown trash and other clean up around town and designated areas. A list of places and things to do will be posted inside Town Hall in the lobby, trash bags will be provided by Solid Waste.

Old Business: A motion was made by Councilman Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dana Clawson to table the dump truck until they had a full quorum. Motion passed.

New Business: A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to pass the final budget reading for Ordinance # 20-A. Motion passed.

Adene Wuertley asked if the council and Mayor would first consider letting them use the school in the old kindergarten room and hall to display stuff for the public that was supposed to be put in the museum. Then asked if they could use the whole old part of the school. Fred and

Donna Kunkel have a display case that they would donate. The Mayor stated that she and Wallace would have to go down there to see if it was useable since the ceiling is falling down and there are water leaks. It was also stated that there is no heat or bathrooms available.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to go into executive session at 7:18 p.m. Motion passed. Council came back into regular session at 8:05 p.m. Mayor Rigano asked the council if there was any objection to anything discussed in the executive session, no one objected.


Lowell Clawson wanted to state for the record that if someone or a place of business wants to rent anything at Town Hall including the gym, council chambers or park it will be \$ 100.00 with a \$25.00 refundable deposit if the place of rent is cleaned up after use. There will be a \$75.00 equipment rental fee with a \$50.00 refundable deposit.


Attorney Mike Roberts will be researching business license stuff and will provide information to the council.
