**Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday March 6, 2019 at 7 P.M.**

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.
Council Members present were Mayor Pro – Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson and Gust Hatanelas. Debra Morgan was excused.
Others present were Attorney Mike Roberts and Clerk Ashley Jones.
Guests present were Police Officer Scott Gardner.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: Election applications can be filled out between March 18, 2019 and April 1, 2019. It's posted on the reader board and doors at Town Hall, Plus Electric, Solid Waste and at the Library.

Approval of the minutes for February 20, 2019 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary, the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Gust Hatanelas and seconded by Lowell Clawson to amend the agenda for March 6, 2019. Motion passed.

Mayor's Report: A letter will be sent out to a family in town who keeps leaving the gym lights on after they use it. A discussion ensued among the council on if the problem continues, then the town look into different options.

The Town had frozen pipes at 411 Indian Paintbrush. The problem was located and a new valve was put in.

Old Business: A motion was made by Gust Hatanelas and seconded by Dana Clawson to charge \$25.00 extra a week to residents who already have a gym membership if their family comes to visit and want to use the gym. Motion passed.

New Business: A motion was made by Gust Hatanelas and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve Amplify Energy to bring in two trailers for their turnaround from May 1, 2019 to the

end of October. Lot rent is \$125.00 plus deposit and utilities a month. Lot rent will be doubled for temporary migrant workers. Motion passed. Attorney Roberts will draw up a contract for each trailer.

Councilman Lowell Clawson made a motion to approve a business license to Zach's Auto Repair. Gust Hatanelas seconded it. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Councilman Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dana Clawson for the Fire Department to purchase two full sets of bunker gear, gloves and hoods instead of purchasing other supplies at this time. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Councilman Lowell Clawson and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to pay Check # 13527 through Check # 13547 including debit card charges and EFT's for the total amount of \$31,752.24. Motion passed.

With no further business this meeting was adjourned at 7:39 p.m.
