Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday January 22, 2020 at 7 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.
Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson, Gust Hatanelas and Debra Morgan.
Others present Attorney Mike Roberts and Clerk Ashley Jones.
Employees present were Maintenance Man Hal Good.
Guests present were Fire Chief Dean Martin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the minutes for January 8, 2019 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Debra Morgan and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to approve the agenda of January 22, 2020. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: We have advertised for a police officer in newspapers, on our website, online and sent several letters to surrounding departments with no luck. Chuck Bayne with Wyoming Law Enforcement Academy sent a letter stating that we are not the only ones in need of an officer there are 30 other agencies looking also. He recommended we send our ad to Wyoming Information Analysis Team Employment to put in their newsletter that is sent state wide.

Court: There was no court held on January 8, 2020, no citations were issued. The next scheduled court date is February 5, 2020.

Water/Sewer: The tank is at 20.6 feet which is normal winter level, overflow is steady with good overflow. Chlorine is average 0.4 milligrams per liter, BIO test sent in and results were good. There is no water issues at this time. The EPA requests some modifications to the water tank, information has been sent to the Engineer along with tank inspection results and photos on the tank interior. Nitrate/Nitrite tests were sent in. The sewer lagoons are normal for this time of year and no outflow. The NPDES report is sent to the state as required each quarter.

Maintenance: The police garage is all cleaned out along with the three stall garage at the school and has been working on moving the snow piles on Indian Paintbrush.

Fire: There was 5 volunteers who attended the Mid-Winter Fire training in Riverton, one volunteer had to be let go due to lack of participation. Jesse Snyder has been working with them so they can get Firefighter 1 certified. Plus Electric Inc. is donating a brand new hose rack to the department. Thank you!

Mayor's Report: Doc Wendling has been elected as the Chairman of the Sweetwater County Commissioners. Congratulations!

The BLM sent some answers to the questions the council had but the council would like some clarification still as to when the cleanup was done to the shooting range. We did receive a copy of their file on the shooting range. Paperwork was given to Attorney Mike Roberts for review.


Old Business: A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to refund Bartlett Oilfield their refund deposit of \$25.00 for renting the council room for their employee benefit meeting on January 16, 2020. Motion passed.

New Business: No executive session was needed.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to pay Check# 14104 through Check# 14131 including all debit card charges and EFT's for a total amount of \$40,318.11. Motion passed.
