Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday August 19, 2020 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.
Council Members present were Gust Hatanelas, and Debbra Morgan.
Councilman Lowell Clawson was excused and Dana Clawson was absent.
Others present were and Clerk Ashely Jones. Attorney Mike Roberts excused.
Employees present was Maintenance Man Hal Good.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the minutes for August 5, 2020 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Gust Hatanelas and seconded by Debbra Morgan to approve the amended agenda for August 19, 2020. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: There was none.

Court: There was no court held on August 5, 2020, no citations were issued. The next scheduled court date is September 2, 2020.

Water/Sewer: The water usage has increased for this time of year. The water tank has been steady at 35 to 36 feet unless we have a water leak, of which we have had two. When this occurs, the tank will be and has been supplemented by Battle Springs. Today the tank was at 31 feet and Battle Springs was turned on for three hours plus bringing the water level up to 36 feet. Meter readings have been as high as 120 thousand gallons with the next reading 90 thousand gallons. The water system is monitored daily and except for leaks, is in good shape. Water tests have been done and were sent in last week. The sewer/lagoons is normal at this time. We will be treating the lagoons with bio-bugs to enhance the function of the bacteria that resides in the lagoons.

Maintenance: The leak at Lupine Circle by Weller's has been repaired, the leak at the school in the parking lot between 107 Bluebell is fixed but has to be backfilled. The mowing and trimming has been done along with the streets brushed and the shop yard cleaned. There was a lot of black tubing in the shop yard that will be cut up into small pieces and go to the dumpsters at Solid Waste and the rest of the fire hydrants will be trimmed around.

Fire: There was fire meeting held on August 17, 2020 with 5 volunteers present. They tested 12 hydrants and discussed the next fire meeting.

Mayor's Report: The park bathrooms still needed to be fixed from the new curb stop to the bathrooms, Silver Sage Plumbing **would not return any phone calls** after coming out to look at it in June so we called Miracle Plumbing out of Casper and they will be coming out to repair the lines and fix the toilets in both bathrooms at the library.

After Mayor Rigano and Debbra Morgan went to Wamsutter to vote, Wamsutter was not following the proper safety guidelines of sanitizing, wearing masks or having people 6 feet apart. Mayor Rigano and Debbra Morgan ended up having to drive to Green River to drop off absentee ballots as Wamsutter wouldn't accept them. They spoke with Destinee Morrison about how Wamsutter was not enforcing safety rules while voting and asked why we couldn't have just voted in Bairoil. She said that it was because we didn't have any election judges and no way for us to get the voting stick turned into them that night. Mayor Rigano and Debbra Morgan stated that we always have had election judges. In the past we have had a Sweetwater County Deputy Sheriff here that has taken ballot information back to Green River on Election Day.


Old Business: There was none.
