Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday February 19, 2020 at 7 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.
Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson and Debbra Morgan.
Gust Hatanelas was excused.
Others present Attorney Mike Roberts and Clerk Ashley Jones.
Employee present was Maintenance Man Harold Good.
Guests present was Fire Chief Dean Martin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the minutes for the minutes of February 5, 2020 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Debbra Morgan and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve the agenda of February 19, 2020. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: There was none.

Court: There was no court held on February 5, 2020, no citations were issued. The next scheduled court date is March 4, 2020.

Water/Sewer: The water usage is average at 25,000 gallons per day, a steady overflow and the tank level remains at 20.6 or half full which is normal for this time of year. The chlorine level varies from 0.4 to 0.5 which is normal. The chlorine level is checked at two locations to determine if the level is consistent. BIO samples have been sent into the state lab, there was one service call this month for water shut off at Frank Atwill's house and he was present when Hal shut the water off. Sewer lagoons remain frozen, normal for this time of year.

Maintenance: Hal has been busy with snow removal, the toilet at the library was not flushing right, that has been fixed. Thermostat covers have been installed in the weight room someone has been changing the temperature. The sensors at the school garage have been adjusted. Snow will be removed from around all fire hydrants.

Fire: The toilet is leaking in the men's bathroom at the fire hall, we will contact a plumber to repair it. The Fire department has a couple trainings coming up, one on March 6th through the 8th in

Rock Springs and another in Riverton on April 28th and 19th, 2020. They held a meeting on Monday February 17, 2020, they started trucks and talked about fire training in Riverton.

Mayor's Report: We received a letter from the Department of Revenue stating that the town is in compliance for tax year 2020.

Old Business: If the Town gets another major snow storm, the council will consider renting a larger piece of equipment to remove the snow piles but for now Maintenance Man Hal Good will work a few extra hours to get them removed with the plow the Town already has.

New Business: A motion was made by Debbra Morgan and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve business licenses for year 2020 to Amplify Energy Operations LLC and to Bartlett Oilfield Service. Motion passed.

Councilman Lowell Clawson made a motion and was seconded by Dana Clawson to go into executive session at 7:24 p.m. Motion passed. Council came back into regular session at 8:04 p.m. Mayor Rigano asked the council if there was any objection to what was discussed in executive session, no one objected. Interviews for the police officer position will be done sometime in March.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to pay Check# 14154 through Check# 14179 including all debit card charges and EFT's excluding Check# 14178. Motion passed. Debbra Morgan made a motion and was seconded by Dana Clawson to pay Check# 14178 to Plus Electric Inc. in the amount of \$2,252.25 for a total amount of \$16,527.08. Motion passed. Lowell Clawson abstained due to pecuniary interest.

With no further business this council meeting was adjourned at 8:06 p.m.
