Old Business: There was none.



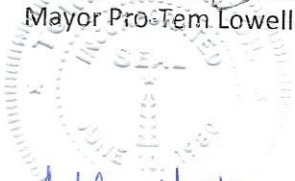


