Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday March 3, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:08 p.m.
Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Gust Hatanelas and Dana Clawson and Debbra Morgan.
Others present were Clerk Ashley Hopkin. Attorney was available by via phone.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: Councilman Debbra Morgan requested discussion on Wyoming gun rights.

Approval of the minutes for February 17, 2021 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to approve the amended agenda of March 3, 2021. Motion passed. Under new business, number two is Discussion of House Bill #124 and number three is DEQ lagoon renewal permit.

Mayor's Report: The pet clinic had to be rescheduled to Monday March 8, 2021 due to a major water leak at the Healthcare Clinic. The pet clinic will be held at Town Hall in the conference room.

After the council reviewing the executive session papers Attorney Terisa Oomens had sent for the council and Mayor to look at, the council would like her to attend the next council meeting for a workshop on it.

Old Business: There was none.

New Business: A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve business licenses to Amplify Energy Corp and to Bartlett Oilfield Service. Motion passed.



A motion was made by Gust Hatanelas and seconded by Lowell Clawson to fill out a termination notice for the DMR reports for the lagoon. **After speaking with Christy Hutchinson from the DEQ she had stated that we never have any discharge so there was no reason for the Town to continue to send in these reports.** Christy Hutchinson will be coming out on Wednesday March 31, 2021 to take some pictures of the Lagoon and look at the DMR reports from the last year to put in her file before the permit is terminated just to show that everything was ok. Motion passed.

No executive session was needed.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to pay Check# 14786 through Check# 14803 including all debit card charges and EFT's for a total amount in bills \$7,306.24. Motion passed.
