Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday April 21, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Debbra Morgan, Dana Clawson and Gust Hatanelas.

Others present were Clerk Ashley Hopkin. Attorney was on standby via telephone.

Guests present were Stetler Hopkin – Fire Department.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the minutes for April 7, 2021 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Debbra Morgan and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to approve the agenda of April 21, 2021. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: There was none.

Court: There was no court held on April 8, 2021. There were no citations issued. The next scheduled court date is May 6, 2021.

Water/Sewer: On March 29, 2021 more water tests were taken to Energy Labs in Casper and Michelle Christopher who is a source water protection specialist came out and worked with Debbie Good on water testing for PH and Alkalinity. Bio tests were taken to Rawlins, papers have been sent in to terminate the DMR's and the North East lagoon discharge pipe has been capped. If we ever have an emergency discharge, we can request an emergency discharge permit. The chlorine has been averaging at 0.3. The tank level is at 20.5 to 20.6 and there are no problems with the sewer lagoons.

Maintenance: Snow plowing continues and putting snow around the tree lines to water them. Scott Sullivan made both sets of runners for the plow, a cap was put on an 8" line at the North East lagoon on the discharge pipe. There was a broken line in the north hallway at the school that has been cleaned up and repaired. Ordered a new set of cutting edges for the plow and a new lock has been put on the council door. After the last big storm there was a lot of standing water over by the school that has been pumped out.

Fire: The Fire Department will be doing some search and rescue training at the school and just have roof ventilation left to complete Firefighter 1.

Mayor's Report: There was none.

Old Business: A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to remove Amplify Water agreement off the table. Amplify backed out of the water agreement to dump their cooling tower water into the Towns sewer/lagoon for the seconded time, so if they ask again, they will be told **NO**. Motion passed.

Lowell Clawson made a motion and was seconded by Gust Hatanelas to remove the Fire Department school training off the table. Motion passed. A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dana Clawson to let the Fire Department to use the school for their training if they notify the Town before using it. Motion passed.


A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to approve buying the shooting range from the BLM. Motion passed. Ashley will contact BLM making sure price quoted is accurate.

Lowell Clawson made a motion and was seconded by Gust Hatanelas to approve the seconded reading of Ordinance 21-B. Motion passed.

New Business: A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dana Clawson to go into executive session at 7:19 p.m. to discuss personnel matters under Wyoming Statue 16-4-405 (a)(ii). Motion passed. Council came back into regular session at 7:27 p.m. Mayor Rigano asked the council if there was any objection as to what was discussed in executive session. No one objected and no action was taken.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to pay Check# 14869 through Check# 14887 including all debit card charges and EFT's excluding Check# 14883. Motion passed. Debbra Morgan made a motion and was seconded by Gust Hatanelas to pay Check#14883 to Plus Electric. Motion passed. Lowell Clawson abstained due to pecuniary interest for a total amount in bills \$13,113.17.

With no further business this council meeting was adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
