Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday February 17, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.
Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Debbra Morgan and Dana Clawson.
Gust Hatanelas was excused.
Others present were Clerk Ashley Hopkin. Attorney was on standby via telephone.
Guests present were Dean Martin.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: A resident had asked if the Solid Waste District #2 was paying to have their hours posted on the Town's outdoor sign. After speaking with the Town's attorney, under Wyoming Statue 151-111, the Town is allowed to post hours for other governmental entities for free.
Solid Waste District #2 is a governmental entity. However, the Town cannot advertise for private businesses for free. All residents must pay to have birthdays, events, etcetera posted on the sign. The price to have something posted is \$5.00 for one week.

Approval of the minutes for February 3, 2021 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Debbra Morgan and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve the agenda of February 17, 2021. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: There was none.

Court: There was no court held on February 4, 2021. There were no citations issued. The next scheduled court date is March 4, 2021.

Water/Sewer: The water level in the tank has been staying at 20.5 and 20.6. The chlorine is averaging 0.3. The lagoons are normal and have had no problems. Maintenance man Hal Good broke the ice off the overflow pipe that was building up on the water tank.

Maintenance: In between plowing snow, piles have been moved off of the streets and put between the trees, a set of skis were built for the plow which were installed on and seem to be working fine. Absaroka Heating and Cooling were out January 27, 2021 and checked the heater at the clinic, which was ok, replaced a pressure switch on the heater at the fire hall and attached a ground wire and adjusted the thermostat on the heater in the police garages.

Fire: They have responded to three medical assists so far this year and have applied for a grant to help purchase new air tanks and pagers. They are looking into finding an additive to the diesel trucks to keep bacteria from forming in them and have a Hazmat training in Rock Springs March 5 through the 7, 2021. Chief Martin had asked the Mayor and Council if they would consider letting the Fire Department use the school for SCBA training along with search and rescue, this will be put on the agenda for the first meeting in April.

Mayor's Report: There was none.

Old Business: There was none.

New Business: A motion was made by Debbra Morgan and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve a business license to Plus Electric Bairoil, LLC, C&L Rentals and Plus Electric Inc. Motion passed. Lowell Clawson abstained due to pecuniary interest.


No executive session was needed.
