Minutes
 Regular Council Meeting
 Wednesday June 2, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
 Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson, Dana Clawson and Debbra Morgan and Gust Hatanelas.
 Others present were Attorney Terisa Oomens and Clerk Ashley Hopkin.
 Guests present were elected Councilman Stetler Hopkin, Alan Thornton and elected Mayor Audra Thornton.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the minutes for May 18, 2021 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Debbra Morgan and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to approve the amended agenda of June 2, 2021. Number 4 is Resolution #2021-02, number 5 Executive Session if needed and number 6 Pay bills. Motion passed.

Mayor's Report: Due to Amplify's shutdown the seconded council meeting in June has been rescheduled to Wednesday June 23, 2021.

Someone turned on the water hydrant in the park and never shut it back off, it was on all weekend and drained the tank down a little. A lock will now be placed on it, so it does not happen again and be unlocked when there is an event going on in the park then locked again.

Resident's have been taking their dogs for walks and not having them on a leash, a letter will be going out to everyone stating when walking their dogs, they must be on a leash.

Mike from Miracle Plumbing is getting us a quote on what it will cost to fix the park bathrooms, so until then we had R&R Rest Stops out of Casper deliver two porta potties.

Old Business: A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Gust Hatanelas to approve Debbie Goods gym rental refund for \$25.00. Motion passed.

Attorney Terisa Oomens will modify the wind blown trash letter and add if the resident's do not pay the clean up bill then the Town will put a (lien on their property.)

New Business: A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve resolution #2022-1 for budget fiscal year 2021/2022. Motion passed.

Councilman Lowell Clawson made a motion and was seconded by Debbra Morgan to accept Gust Hatanelas letter of resignation. Motion passed. Gust Hatanelas abstained due to pecuniary interest.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dana Clawson to accept Gust Hatanelas letter of termination of his 3-stall garage lease at 101 Bluebell (behind the school), also accept Stetler Hopkins letter of termination of his garage lease at 96 Bluebell approve his request to rent the 3-stall garage at 101 Bluebell (behind the school) when Gust Hatanelas's lease is done. Motion passed.

Motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to approve resolution 2021-02 to raise the monthly water rate for non-seniors from \$35.00 to \$40.00 and lowering sewer rates from \$25.00 to \$20.00. All seniors will be charged from \$20.00 to \$22.00 for water and from \$13.00 to \$8.00. This will take affect on June's billing statement.


No executive session was needed.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Debbra Morgan to pay Check#14932 through Check#14952 including all debit card charges and EFT's for a total amount in bills \$8,007.73. Motion passed.

With no further business this council meeting was adjourned at 7:26 p.m.
