Minutes
Regular Council Meeting
Wednesday June 23, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Sue Ann Rigano called this meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.
Council Members present were Mayor Pro-Tem Lowell Clawson and Dana Clawson.
Debbra Morgan and Gust Hatanelas were absent.
Others present were Attorney Terisa Oomens and Clerk Ashley Hopkin.
Guests present were elected Councilman Stetler Hopkin, Alan Thornton and elected Mayor Audra Thornton.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Public Comment: There was none.

Approval of the minutes for June 2, 2021 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dana Clawson to approve the agenda of June 23, 2021. Motion passed.

Monthly Reports:

Police: There was none.

Court: There was no court held on June 3, 2021. There were no citations issued. The next scheduled court date is July 8, 2021.

Water/Sewer: The BIO tests have been sent in, and the lead and copper has been sent in, both test results came back fine. On June 3, 2021 Mark Court and Michelle Christopher came to Town Hall and gave a three hour math class for Debbie Good and a Highway employee from Muddy Gap. When shutdown started there was no power to the chlorine building for a couple days and had to turn on Battle Springs for a short period of time to bring the tank level back up. The water meter behind Bluebell is not working so pictures were taken and sent to Engineer Tom Pilch to see what we needed to do and what to order. The chlorine levels have been good running between 0.3 and 0.4. The sewer lagoons are good.

Maintenance: Mowing and trimming has been done at Town Hall, rentals, trencher park, fire hall, the tree lines, along the roadside and the corrals. The leach field is still holding good from the repairs, so are the spring boxes and the well house. Burning is continuing on Wednesday's.

Fire: A non-mandatory meeting was held on June 2, 2021 with six volunteers present, they washed hoses and hung them up on the rack, hauled trash to the dump and swept out the shop. On June 3, 2021

they had six volunteers present and washed trucks for Monday's ceremony, cleaned the shop and set up a schedule for June so at least three volunteers would be here. Chief Dean Martin selected Stetler Hopkin as the new Assistant Fire Chief and Butch McFall as the secretary. A meeting was held on June 7, 2021 five volunteers were present, Dalton Sanders the State's Fire Marshall came down presenting the volunteers with their badges and certificates for completing Firefighter 1. Everyone looked very professional with their new shirts! Congratulations to all!

Mayor's Report: We received an email from Tom Pilch saying that he does not think we need to replace the altitude valve. He is looking to find someone who can come down to adjust it for us.

Debbie Good passed her water test on the first try and has since then put in enough hours to get her water certificate. Great job! She is still working on the sewer certificate.

Town Hall will be closed on Monday July 5, 2021 in observance of 4th of July.

Old Business: A public notice will go out to all the resident's about wasting water while watering your yard. Examples will be given with the best times to water. If residents don't comply with the notice, then the Town's Attorney will send a letter to those people and more drastic measures will be taken.

New Business: A motion was made by Lowell Clawson and seconded by Dana Clawson to table items for bid until Clerk Ashley Hopkin can get some more information for the Mayor and Council before making a discussion. Motion passed.


