Regular Council Meeting  
Wednesday March 17, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

Approval of the minutes for March 3, 2021 as they were posted according to law. With no changes necessary the minutes stand as written.

Monthly Reports:

Police: There was none. The Town has posted another ad with the Rawlins Times for a Police Officer.

Court: There was no court held on March 4, 2021. There were no citations issued. The next scheduled court date is April 8, 2021.

Water/Sewer: On March 9, 2021 the BIO tests were sent in and came back normal. The chlorine level has averaged 0.3 and the water tank is at 20.5 to 20.6. The sewer lagoon has had no problems.

Maintenance: There was a water leak at the Healthcare clinic, Mike from Mircale Plumbing out of Casper was called but he has been tied up and busy with other jobs and not sure when he can make it out here to get it fixed. Maintenance Man Hal Good will get the parts and get it repaired. After this last snow storm that we got, the plow blade will have to be welded where it has a cracked frame by the pin.

Fire: There were five volunteers that went to Hazmat training in Rock Springs Friday March 5 through Sunday March 7, 2021. They have a few more things to complete then all of them will have passed Fire Fighter 1.

Mayor's Report: There was none.

Old Business: There was none.

New Business: The Town has been having problems with Union Wireless internet service. We've spoken to a Union representative and they either say the weather or that we have gone over on our usage. The Town's I.T. guy has gone in and printed off the speed and usage to show our system is fine and we have not used as much as they are saying. We will be looking into another internet provider called Star Link.

No executive session was needed.


